

Ask the children how many pebbles could be in each bucket.


Could this bucket have 0 pebbles?

These are the bossy (imperative) verbs


 If you have already written your instructions, highlight the bossy verbs you have used. If you havent used a bossy verb, can you add one in to your sentence/caption?
