

Task:



Today in maths we are continuing to compare number sentences using the greater than, less than and equal to symbols



Topic:
(15-20 minutes)

Jack and the Beanstalk and Instructions:

Jack needs some help! He needs to know how to make a sandwich for his mother. Could you help him by writing these instructions in order? Don't forget to add a number for each instruction. Can you underline the bossy (imperative) verbs?

- Spread the margarine on the bread
- Get two slices of bread
- Cut the sandwich in half
- Put the slices of bread together
- Spread the jam on one slice of bread
- Put the sandwich on the plate

Geography
(10-15 minutes)

Measuring rainfall:

Over the next week we are going to be measuring the amount of rainfall we get. You will need a jug with measurements on it in millilitres and a 7 day grid that looks like this:

Stand the container somewhere outside. At the end of the day, have a look at the jug and record how much rainfall it has collected. Write the amount in the box.
