Phonics (20-30 minutes)

Today we are revising the 'igh' trigraph.

Task:

- 1) With support from a grownup, read the 'Groovy Goat Dance' and highlight the words with the 'igh' trigraph in them.

SENTENCE: I might like some milk with my cookies.



Maths (10-15 minutes)

Task: If you don't have dice, you could use your number flashcards up to 10 - turn them upside down and select at random.
